These communal networks allow users to be involved in decision making where the goal is to provide members with effective management. However, even with these progressive systems, women are often excluded from the decision-making processes over water control and are not often in positions of water management. The idea of communal water supply and management tends to be romanticized in its portrayal of communities as equitable social structures, although unequal power relations are prevalent and resources allocation based on gendered division of labor is common. Experts have proposed that the localization of water management must be accompanied by greater inclusion of women as participants in the creation of the enhanced sustainability of this resource.
